HOMEOWNER REHABILITATION ASSISTANCE

THE GRIFFIN HOUSING AUTHORITY HAS BEEN AWARDED THE COMMUNITY HOME INVESTMENT PROGRAM GRANT

The Community HOME Investment Program (CHIP) provides grants to local governments, nonprofit organizations and public housing authorities to address the needs of affordable housing development in their communities. CHIP funds may be used to build new affordable single family homes for resale and to provide housing rehabilitation for low-income and moderate-income home owners.

Eligible Activities


Homeowner Rehabilitation: CHIP funds may be used to assist existing low income homeowners by providing rehabilitation assistance to their homes.

New Construction: CHIP funds may be used to build single family homes for low-to-moderate income homebuyers.
