AVAILABILITY:

Available in all territory served by the retail distribution lines of the City.

APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to all domestic uses in a separately metered single-family or apartment dwelling unit.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single phase, 60 hertz, at a standard secondary voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

SUMMER – May through September

Base Charge	\$12.00
First 500 kWh.....@	7.6¢ per kWh
Next 500 kWh	8.4¢ per kWh
Over 1,000 kWh	10.4¢ per kWh

NON-SUMMER – October through April

Base Charge	\$12.00
First 500 kWh.....@	7.6¢ per kWh
Next 500 kWh	6.6¢ per kWh
Over 1,000 kWh	6.2¢ per kWh

Minimum Monthly Bill: \$12.00

PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT:

The amounts calculated at the above rate are subject to increase or decrease according to the monthly Purchased Power Cost Adjustment (PPCA) calculation. The current PCA is \$0.018/kWh.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE COST RECOVERY

The monthly environmental compliance cost recovery adjustment in cents per kWh shall be added to all metered bills for service. The ECCR shall represent an amount no higher than that which may be calculated using the economic compliance cost reporting issued from time to time by the City’s principal electricity supplier, MEAG Power. ECCR changes will normally occur annually with changes becoming effective with the first day of a new fiscal year. The current ECCR is \$00.065/kWh

MULTIPLE SERVICE:

Under special circumstances and with the approval of the City, two or more dwelling units may be served through a single meter. In this case the block limits above will be multiplied by the number of units and the minimum monthly bill will likewise be \$12.00 times the number of units.

LATE PAYMENTS:

All bills not paid by the due date are delinquent and subject to a late fee and/or cut-off.
