



## Equipment Operator II (Non-Dot)

Water/Wastewater

Starting Rate: \$11.21/hour

### JOB SUMMARY

This position is responsible for the operation of a variety of mowing and other equipment in the maintenance of Blanton Mill and Shoal Creek.

### MAJOR DUTIES

- Mows the grounds using a bush hog lawn tractor.
- Operates weed trimmers and a variety of other small engine ground maintenance equipment.
- May perform other maintenance duties to keep the building and grounds clean.
- Performs pre-trip inspections to assigned equipment or vehicle; checks brakes, lights, belts, hoses, fluid levels, air pressure, etc., reports equipment or vehicle service, maintenance, or repair needs to immediate supervisor.
- Performs related duties.

### KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED BY THE POSITION

- Knowledge of the operation and maintenance of assigned vehicles and equipment.
- Knowledge of departmental and city policies and procedures.
- Skill in the operation of lawn tractors and other small equipment.
- Skill in comprehending and following safety rules and regulations.
- Skill in understanding and following oral and/or written policies, procedures and instructions.
- Skill in communicating effectively with others.

### SUPERVISORY CONTROLS

The Plant Manager assigns work in terms of somewhat general instructions. The supervisor spot-checks completed work for compliance with instructions and established procedures, accuracy, and the nature and propriety of the final results.

### GUIDELINES

Guidelines include city and department policies and procedures, supervisory instructions, and safety regulations. These guidelines are generally clear and specific, but may require some interpretation in application.

### COMPLEXITY/SCOPE OF WORK

- The work consists of related mower operation duties. Inclement weather contribute to the complexity of the position.
- The purpose of this position is to operate mowing equipment in the maintenance of Blanton Mill and Shoal Creek. Successful performance contributes to well maintained city grounds and infrastructure.

### CONTACTS

- Contacts are typically with co-workers, other city employees.
- Contacts are typically to give or exchange information and provide services.

### **PHYSICAL DEMANDS/ WORK ENVIRONMENT**

- The work is typically performed while intermittently sitting, standing, stooping, walking, bending, or crouching. The employee frequently lifts light and heavy objects, climbs ladders, uses tools or equipment requiring a high degree of dexterity, and distinguishes between shades of color.
- The work is typically performed outdoors where the employee may be exposed to noise, dust, dirt, grease, machinery with moving parts, contagious or infectious diseases, irritating chemicals, and cold or inclement weather. The work requires the use of protective devices such as masks, goggles, or gloves.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- High School diploma or GED preferred.
- Experience with a variety of lawn equipment.
- Possession of or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia for the type of vehicle or equipment operated.

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
