Training will be provided on all field sampling and monitoring equipment with no previous knowledge required.

REQUIREMENTS: We prefer someone seeking any degree in a Science or Engineering field, but will consider those seeking other degrees as well. Selected interns must provide a copy of their acceptance letter from an accredited college or university or grades from the previous college semester before starting work their first summer. Must be 17 years of age or older to be considered. Must pass a comprehensive background check that includes but is not limited to a drug test and a criminal/driving background check. Must have a valid driver's license with a good driver's history.
