JOB SUMMARY

Maintains and landscapes parks and right-of-ways throughout the city.

MAJOR DUTIES

- Maintains rights-of-way; removes trash and debris; mows grass.
- Maintains landscaping on city grounds.
- Repairs excavation sites.
- Supervises the work of state inmates; transports inmates to and from work sites.
- Maintains and repairs assigned vehicles, tools and equipment.
- Purchases needed supplies and equipment.
- Completes required reports.
- May direct the work of a crew.
- Performs related duties.

KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED BY THE POSITION

- Knowledge of landscape maintenance principles and practices.
- Knowledge of department policies and procedures.
- Knowledge of the policies and guidelines governing the supervising of inmate labor.
- Skill in the use of a variety of job-related equipment and tools.
- Skill in the analysis of problems and the development and implementation of solutions.
- Skill in the installation, repair and maintenance of landscaping.
- Skill in the repair and maintenance of job-related tools and equipment.
- Skill in oral and written communication

SUPERVISORY CONTROLS

The Supervisor assigns work in terms of general instructions. The supervisor spot-checks work for compliance with procedures, accuracy, and the nature and propriety of the final results.

GUIDELINES

Guidelines include department policies and procedures. These guidelines require judgment, selection and interpretation in application.

COMPLEXITY/SCOPE OF WORK

- The work consists of related technical duties. Heavy traffic and inclement weather contribute to the complexity of the position.
- The purpose of this position is to perform technical duties in the repair and maintenance of landscaping. Success in this position results in the proper repair of excavation sites.

CONTACTS

- Contacts are typically with other city employees and members of the general public.
- Contacts are typically to provide services, to give or exchange information, to resolve problems, or to motivate

or influence persons.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS/ WORK ENVIRONMENT

- The work is typically performed while bending, crouching or stooping. The employee occasionally lifts light and heavy objects, climbs ladders, uses tools or equipment requiring a high degree of dexterity, and distinguishes between shades of color.
- The work is typically performed outdoors, occasionally in cold or inclement weather. The employee is exposed to noise, dust, dirt, grease, and machinery with moving parts. Work requires the use of protective devices such as masks, goggles, gloves, etc.

SUPERVISORY AND MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY

None.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High School diploma or GED.
- Sufficient experience to understand the basic principles relevant to the major duties of the position, usually associated with holding a similar position for one to two years.
- Possession of a valid driver's license issued by the State of Georgia.
