**What:** Adopt-A-Stream Visual Habitat and Watershed Assessment Workshop

**When:** Saturday April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 from 10 am to 2 pm.

**Where:** Spalding County Extension Office – 835 Memorial Drive, Griffin 30223. In the same parking lot as the Spalding County Senior Center.

In partnership with Spalding County Extension, City of Griffin is offering a free workshop where participants learn all about where water comes from and how it is affected by human impact. Participants will learn how to determine the quality of the water by looking at the land around the stream, to delineate topographical maps and to quickly assess the health of a stream, based on the surrounded stream corridor. Prior experience or knowledge not required. Great for teachers, students, Boy and Girl Scouts, 4-H'ers or anyone interested in water and nature. There will be a short certification exam at the end of the workshop. Students 18 and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

Bring a sack lunch and your water bottle. Wear old clothing, and shoes that you do not mind getting dirty or wet. Bring your water boots and waders if you have them.
