



Wyomia Tyus Olympic Park **1301 Cowan Rd, Griffin, GA 30223**

Completed in 1999, Wyomia Tyus Park is 164 acres of beautiful landscape. Named after an Olympic gold medalist, the park is a favorite among locals with its 3 acre lake, fountain, 7 soccer fields, 5 baseball diamonds, and batting cages.



Doc Holliday Walking Tour **209 N 13th Street, Griffin, GA 30223**

Visitors spend hours at the Doc Holliday Museum discovering the life and achievements of the great Southern gentleman. The museum houses unpublished photos, books, and other documents which help to shape the life of the man.

Stonewall Confederate Cemetery **800 Memorial Drive, Griffin, GA 30224**

Stonewall Cemetery is located on part of a plot given as a burial site by General Lewis Lawrence Griffin, when he founded Griffin in 1840. Several hundred Confederates and one Union soldier, casualties of the Battle of Atlanta and Jonesboro, from the hospital at old Synodical College and the battlefields, are buried here.



UGA Research and Education Garden **129 W Ellis Rd, Griffin, GA 30223**

A 65-acre facility located on the UGA Griffin Campus that is dedicated to the development, evaluation, and delivery of science-based management practices for southern landscapes. The Garden provides a unique blend of mission-oriented research and education.



Downtown Shops And Restaurants **Downtown Griffin, GA 30224**

The up-in-coming area of downtown thrives with clothing boutiques, antique shops, retailers, and over 20 restaurants to dine. Visit restaurants in the Arts and Entertainment District to get your to-go alcoholic beverage, ages 21+ and up, to stroll the streets from 4pm to midnight daily.



Kiwanis Mountain Bike Trail **National Guard Road, Griffin, GA 30224**

With two loops of varying length and intensity, the Kiwanis Mountain Bike Trail is great for a quick ride or an afternoon. The one mile loop is great for beginners and the 4 mile loop is for those who are more experienced.

City Park and Golf Course **625 Camp Northern Road, Griffin, GA 30224**

The City Park consists of 200 acres which include five pavilions, six tennis courts, two handicap-accessible playgrounds, city pool, city golf course and ball fields. City Park Community Center is located within City Park. The facility features a one court gymnasium, work out room and meeting rooms.



Broad Street Mill **324 East Broad Street Griffin, GA 30224**

Founded in 2013 as Broad Street Mill, the building was originally built in 1908 as the Norman Buggy Company. Today it is home to over 14 shops and an additional 15 individual booths. You can literally buy your antiques, clothing, home decor, organic foods, have furniture upholstered, enjoy a tea party, sign up to have your wood floors refinished, and partake in a yoga class.



Griffin Regional Welcome Center **143 North Hill Street, Griffin, GA 30224**

The late Mr. B. R. Blakely, Sr., a prominent local citizen and entrepreneur involved in agribusiness, banking and wholesale distribution, originally constructed the building in 1899. Today, the building is home to the Griffin + Spalding Chamber of Commerce, a new gift shop, and the Griffin Museum.



6th Street Bridge **6th Street Griffin, GA 30224**

Georgia has very few metal truss bridges, and as such, a bridge like this one, which would stand out in the most truss-rich state in the country, is so rare and significant that it might be the most important historic bridge in the entire state. The Downtown Council host "Dinner on the Bridge" once a year in the spring.
