

Still Branch Regional Reservoir Regulations

1. The Reservoir will be open 7 days a week (Monday – Sunday) with the hours of operation being:

March – November (Daylight Savings): 7 am – 7 pm December – February: 8 am – 5 pm

- 2. Access to the reservoir shall be made only at the entrance gate located at **4433 Hwy 18**, **Molena**, **Georgia 30258**.
- 3. Parking is permitted only in designated spaces. If lot is FULL DO NOT FISH.
- 4. Parking is \$3.00 per day. Money shall be placed in envelope and deposited in the marked box by the boat ramp. The perforated receipt on the back of envelope shall be torn off and place on the dash of the vehicle so it is visible for easy inspection.
- 5. Vehicles not obeying parking rules and hours of operation will be towed at owner's expense.
- 6. Fishing is permitted; anyone wishing to do so must have a valid fishing license and use an electric motor boat only. If a person has a gas motor, it must be lifted so as to not to touch the water at all times.
- 7. Once boaters cast off from the recreation area they are to remain in the boat except in emergency situations.
- 8. Wading, swimming or bathing is prohibited at all times.
- 9. All individuals fishing must comply with the State of Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) fishing rules and regulations, creel limits, safety, licenses, etc... at all times. Only exception to the Georgia DNR rules and regulations is as follows: 12-inch minimum length on bass with a DAILY LIMIT OF 5, only one (1) can be over 16-inches in length. - 10. Individuals who elect to fish from the bank must do so within the "MARKED" boundaries.
- 11. The use of a set hook, trotline, seine or fish basket is prohibited.
- 12. Individuals may be required to show proper identification upon request to an authorized representative of the City of Griffin and/or Department of Natural Resources.
- 13. No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be allowed on reservoir property.
- 14. Operation or use of any audio or noise producing device, motorized equipment, or vehicles in such a manner to unreasonably annoy or endanger other persons is prohibited.



- 15. Lewd, profane or obscene language and/or actions are not permitted and violators will be expelled from property.
- 16. Individuals shall not discharge any gray water or waste matter on site. Trash and litter shall be self-contained and disposed of properly.
- 17. Firearms including but not limited to ammunition, bows and arrows, loaded projectile firing devices and explosives are prohibited at all times.
- 18. Open fires are prohibited on property.

Failure to abide by the rules and regulations will result in expulsion from the recreation area. Your cooperation in abiding by the rules and regulations will assist us in providing a safe, enjoyable outing while protecting our valuable water resources.
