

Heads Creek Reservoir Regulations

- 1. Reservoir is open daily from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- 2. Boats powered by **electric** motors or paddles **only**. Gas motors may be attached to boats but not used.
- 3. Once boaters cast off from the recreation area they are to stay in boats except in emergency situations.
- 4. Wading, swimming or bathing is prohibited.
- All individuals that are fishing must comply with the State of Georgia Department of Natural
 Resources fishing rules and regulations, creel limits, safety, licenses, etc., and a 12" minimum length on
 bass.
- 6. The use of a set hook, trotline, seine or fish basket is prohibited.
- 7. No fishing from bridges.
- 8. Individuals may be required to show proper identification upon request by an authorized representative of the City of Griffin and/or the Department of Natural Resources.
- 9. **No alcoholic beverages** of any kind will be allowed on reservoir property.
- 10. Operation or use of any audio or noise producing device, motorized equipment, or vehicles in such a manner to unreasonably annoy or endanger other persons is prohibited.
- 11. Lewd, profane or obscene language, and/or actions are not permitted and violators will be expelled.
- 12. Individuals shall not discharge any gray water or waste matter on the site and shall keep their trash and litter self-contained and disposed of properly.
- 13. No firearms will be permitted; ammunition, bows and arrows, loaded projectile firing devices, and explosives are prohibited.
- 14. Open fires are prohibited in the recreation area.

Failure to abide by the regulations will result in expulsion from the recreation area. Your cooperation in abiding by the regulations will assist us in providing a safe, enjoyable outing, while protecting valuable water resources.
